Key Responsibilities:

- **Prize procurement** - Secure prizes for the live/silent auctions, raffle and other in-kind support to maximise funds raised at the event.
- **Logistics support** - Support the batyr team to liaise with vendors, plan event logistics, and bring creative ideas to life.
- **Volunteer support** - Assist in the recruitment and management of volunteers on the night (approx. 50+ volunteers required).

- Expected time commitment: 2-3 hours per week including independent work
